This training is designed to help the new Scoutmaster or Assistant Scoutmaster get up to speed quickly with their new leadership position! This training is divided into three parts

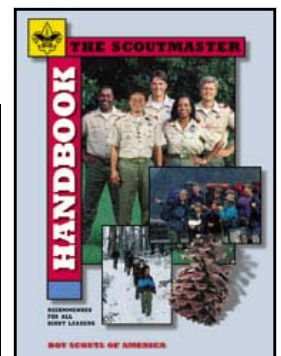
Part I: The Role of the Scoutmaster in a Boy-Led Troop

- ◆ This training promises to be fun and informative.

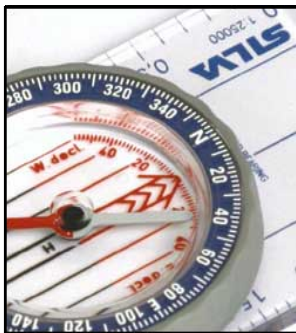

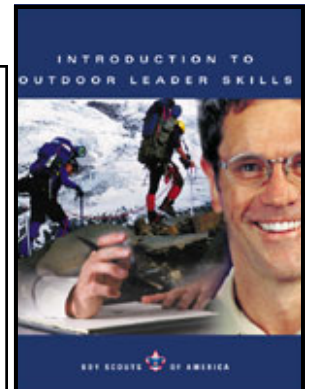

Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills

Scoutmaster and Assistant Scoutmaster Specifics Part IV is a hands-on program that gives adult leaders the practical skills to lead Scouts in the out-of-doors. The skills taught will introduce the participants to the basic Scout outdoor skills through the First Class rank. Instructors will help you learn how to set up camp, cook, work with woods tools and about ropes, first aid, planning campfire programs, map reading and compass skills, hiking and packing techniques, nature identification, and Leave No Trace. Each outdoor session will bring to life the pages of the Boy Scout Handbook to help you deliver the promise of Scouting to yourself and the youth you serve. It will increase your comfort level and give you confidence as a trained, skilled leader. The program will also give you the opportunity to work with other Scout leaders from your area, meet new friends, and reinforce skill techniques with fellow unit leaders.
